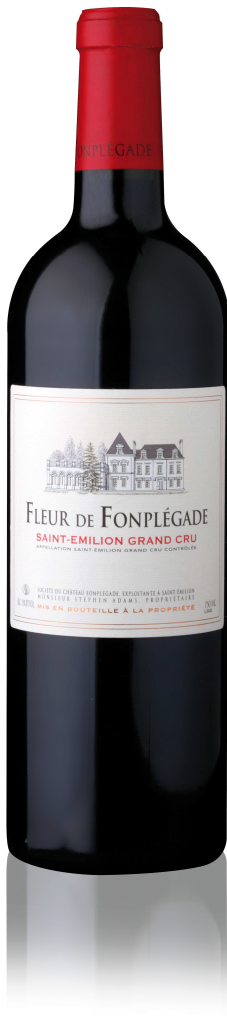


FLEUR DE FONPLEGADE SAINT-EMILION GRAND CRU 2008

VINIFICATION AND AGEING:

VATS: Wooden vats with tronconic shape
VATTING TIME: 35 to 40 days
AGEING: 15 to 18 months
BARRELS: 40 % new French oak and 60 % one year French oak

THE WINE:

WINE VARIETIES: 85% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc and 10% Cabernet Sauvignon
PRODUCTION: 2,000 cases

TASTING NOTES:

APPEARANCE: Deep purple color
NOSE: Fresh red fruits, vanilla and cocoa notes
MOUTH: Great balance, intense notes of red and black fruits, with a long finish
